Attachment #2B - Amendment 2014-071 (Tellico Village Greenway) - Add project to the 2014-2017 TIP for the amount of \$100,000 total (\$80,000 federal and \$20,000 local) in L-STP funds for FY 2015 to develop a study for a linear park greenway to run parallel to State Hwy 444 (Tellico Pkwy) from US Hwy 321 south to State Hwy 72.

BAC members will continue to be involved with the TPO Bicycle Program, and will be able to use their time and energy working with the newly formed advocacy organization, Bike Walk Knoxville. Staff is exploring the creation of a transportation advisory committee, that will be multi-modal in nature, to assist in the update of the Regional Mobility plan.

6. Transit Representation on the Executive Board

Item Summary: MAP-21 requires that representation by provider(s) of public transportation be on the Policy Board of MPO's that have a population of greater than 200,000. 7. Highway Trust Fund Status

There appears to be a willingness in Congress to pass a 9 month short term bill with approximately \$11 billion of funding to shore up the Highway Trust Fund. This action can provide additional time for Congress to pass a long term bill and avoid an immediate funding crisis in the transportation industry.
