Item Summary: MAP-21 requires that representation by provider(s) of public transportation be on the Policy Board of MPO's that have a population of greater than 200,000. The Technical Committee and the Executive Board have approved a recommendation that public transportation membership on the TPO Board be a representative of the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 – Urban Area – Designated Recipient (currently the City of Knoxville). This is the second reading of the DRAFT Amended TPO Executive Board By-laws.

3. Motion to Approve a Resolution to Approve the Title VI Report Presenter: Doug Burton, TPO Staff

Item Summary: As the recipient of Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funding, the TPO is required to prepare a Title VI Report every three years. The requirements are outlined in FTA Circular 4702.1B that details the information, data, and maps that must be submitted. It is required that the Executive Board approve the Report. The TPO follows the FTA recommendation that the Report be structured to mirror the FTA Title VI Report checklist. The TPO is required to follow Title VI with all sources of federal transportation funding, but this Report specifically focuses on FTA funding.
