<u>Attachment #2A - Amendment 2014-206 (Smart Trips - Ridesharing Program)</u> - Amend the project by changing FY 2015 programmed CMAQ funds to the awarded amount of \$155,000 and adding FY 2016 programmed funds in the amount of \$160,000. The total project cost is now \$450,000. This is a TDOT awarded CMAQ project.

Attachment #2B - Amendment 2014-225 (Bike Parking Program) - Amend this project by adding it to the 2014-2017 TIP. The total project cost is \$30,000 in CMAQ funds. Each fiscal year (2015, 2016, and 2017) is programmed with \$8,000 federal and \$2,000 local match for a total of \$10,000. This is a TDOT awarded CMAQ project.

<u>Attachment #2C - Amendment 2014-226 (Reducing Emission with UPS and Autogas)</u> - Amend the project by adding it to the 2014-2017 TIP. The total project cost is \$548,119 in CMAQ funds. FY 2015 is programmed with \$426,619 federal and \$121,500 local for a total of \$548,119. This is a TDOT awarded CMAQ project.

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Attachment #2D - Amendment 2014-227 (DHL – Driving Autogas Use for a Cleaner Metro Knoxville) - Amend the project by adding it to the 2014-2017 TIP. The total project cost is \$57,312 in CMAQ funds. FY 2015 is programmed with \$44,112 federal and \$13,200 local for a total of \$57,312. This is a TDOT awarded CMAQ project.

<u>Attachment #2E - Amendment 2014-228 (Knox County Traffic Signal Coordination Project)</u> - Amend the project by adding it to the 2014-2017 TIP. The total project cost is \$105,500 in CMAQ funds. FY 2015 is programmed with 100% federal funds at \$105,500. This is a TDOT awarded CMAQ project.

Attachment #2F - Amendment 2014-229 (Knox County Advanced Traffic Management System - Phase 1) - Amend the project by adding it to the 2014-2017 TIP. The total project cost is \$1,428,000 in CMAQ funds. FY 2015 is programmed with 100% federal funds in the amount of \$223,000 and FY 2016 is programmed with 100% federal funds in the amount of \$1,205,000 for a total of \$1,428,000. This is a TDOT awarded CMAQ project.

<u>Attachment #2G - Amendment 2014-230 (Oak Ridge Signal Timing Optimization)</u> - Amend the project by adding it to the 2014-2017 TIP. The total project cost is \$237,500. FY 2015 is programmed with 100% federal funds in the amount of \$237,500. This is a TDOT awarded CMAQ project.

<u>Attachment #2H - Amendment 2014-231 (Farragut Traffic Signal Improvement Project)</u> - Amend the project by adding it to the 2014-2017 TIP. The total project cost is \$258,000 in CMAQ funds. FY 2015 is programmed with 100% federal funds in the amount of \$258,000. The is a TDOT awarded CMAQ project.

Attachment #2I - Amendment 2014-232 (Lenoir City ITS: Signal System Design) - Amend the project by adding it to the 2014-2017 TIP. The total project cost is \$1,333,500. FY 2015 is programmed with 100% federal funds in the amount of \$168,500 and FY 2016 is programmed with 100% federal funds in the amount of \$1,165,000 for a total project cost of \$1,333,500. This is a TDOT awarded CMAQ project.
