 <u>Attachment #3B - 2014-076 (Buttermilk Road Resurfacing)</u> - Amend this project by adding it to the TIP for FY 2016 and L-STP funding totaling \$795,000 (\$636,000 federal and \$159,000 local) to resurface and

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Attachment #3C - 2014-077 (Maryville Alcoa Advanced Traffic Management System Phase II) -

Amend the project by adding it to the TIP for the Maryville Alcoa Advanced Traffic Management System Phase II, that will provide upgrades in signal system communications and equipment along US 411 / US 321, US 129, and SR 33. The total project cost is \$2,675,000. FY 2016 is programmed with 100% federal CMAQ funds in the amount of \$155,000 and FY 2017 is programmed with 100% federal CMAQ funds in the amount of \$2,520,000.

Attachment #3D - 2014-078 (Chapman Highway Advanced Traffic Management System) - Amend the project by adding it to the TIP to expand the City of Knoxville's Advanced Traffic Management System along Chapman Highway. The total project cost is \$1,985,000. FY 2016 is programmed with 100% federal CMAQ funds in the amount of \$260,000 and FY 2017 is programmed with 100% federal CMAQ funds in the amount of \$1,725,000.

Attachment #3E - 2014-079 (City of Loudon Traffic Flow Improvement Project) - Amend the project by adding it to the TIP to replace outdated infrastructure at four signalized intersections including updating vehicle detection, signal system communication and coordination. The total project cost is \$1,343,400. FY 2016 is programmed with 100% federal CMAQ funds in the amount of \$108,000 and FY 2017 is programmed with 100% federal CMAQ funds in the amount of \$1,235,400.
