Attachment #2A - Amendment 2014-049 (First Creek Greenway) – Amend the project by changing the Project Name, Description, Termini and map to be more consistent with the actual location of the greenway alignment as well as the project description in the approved CE document. The primary change involves clarification of the beginning point of the greenway being at the intersection of Broadway and E Woodland Ave rather than the generic landmark terminology used previously of Fulton High School. Attachment #2B - Amendment 2014-028 (Pistol Creek Greenway – Phase IV) – Amend the project by modifying the Project Description, Length and map to be more consistent with the actual location of the proposed greenway alignment. The overall project scope and termini are unchanged and this amendment corrects an error in the previous project length calculation.

Attachment #2C - Amendment 2014-023 (Everett Rd / I-40 Greenway) – Amend project by changing funding type for all phases from L-STP/Local to 100% Local funds. The total amount of L-STP funding removed from this project is \$320,000 and is being shifted to project 2014-082 (Union Road/N. Hobbs Road Improvements).
