2. Motion to Approve Recommendations for Distribution of FTA Section 5307 Urbanized Area Formula Program and FTA Section 5339 Bus and Bus Facilities Program Funds

Item Summary: Each fiscal year the urban area receives from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) an allocation of Section 5307 – Urban Area and Section 5339 Bus and Bus Facilities funds. These funds are used to provide public transit services. The City of Knoxville is the Designated Recipient of these funds. The City of Knoxville has an application process for agencies interested in receiving these funds. City of Knoxville Mayor Rogero and the TPO staff reviewed the applications. The City has the responsibility of making the final recommendation for funding distribution. Staff will review the Mayor's recommendation which will be shared prior to the meeting. TIP changes to reflect the distributions will be done as adjustments, which do not require formal approval. Staff recommends approval.
