The purpose of these Plans is to create a strategic method for replacing transit capital assets. Each transit agency must prepare a TAM Plan and the TPO is required to set regional performance targets for the urban area. Targets are set by asset category, which includes Rolling Stock, Equipment, and Facilities. The TPO must use these Targets when measuring performance progress when updating the Long Range Mobility Plan and the Transportation Improvement Program. Staff recommends approval.
