4. Presentation on Regional Bike/Pedestrian Crash Reports

Item Summary: Staff will share an updated summary of regional crash data, including reports from jurisdictions outside Knox County, including Anderson, Blount & Loudon counties, and the cities of Alcoa, Lenoir City, Loudon, Maryville, Oak Ridge & Sevierville. 5. Discussion of Annual TDOT Safety Performance Targets

Presenter: Mike Conger, TPO Staff and TDOT Headquarters Staff

Item Summary: Federal regulations require states and MPOs to establish performance targets for five separate safety factors on an annual basis. TDOT established statewide targets for the 2015-2019 period effective on 8/31/18 and now the TPO has 180 days (until 2/27/19) to either: agree to support the state target or establish specific numeric targets for a safety performance measure specific to our region. Staff from TDOT Strategic Planning and Safety Office divisions will review the targets and current safety funding programs at TDOT.
