Please see the following and attached information summarizing a proposed modification to add a project/funding to and existing grouping in the FY 2023-2026 Knoxville TPO TIP.

Proposed Modification #306 - TIP ID# 23-2023-308 (Travel Congestion & Clean Air Improvement Grouping [KAT Electric Transit Bus Purchase]):

Modify grouping to add one project to the grouping. Funding is programmed for KAT to purchase seven (7) electric transit buses in FY 2024 at a cost of \$8,960,000 CMAQ (\$7,168,000 federal/\$1,792,00). The funds are CMAQ PM 2.5 funding and will be flexed to FTA. This modification adds \$8,960,000 CMAQ (\$7,168,000 federal/\$1,792,00) to the grouping and TIP. The total grouping cost is increased to \$21,909,707.

This modification was originally (and incorrectly) routed to multimodal and they don't provide concurrence on modifications. Kim Brymer is working with multimodal to coordinate approval in the eSTIP, but it appears we need LP concurrence to proceed.
