
## Maps of Knoxville Region Air Quality Status

## Ozone – Maintenance Area for 2008 8-hour Standard


The Knoxville Region was designated as Nonattainment for the 2008 Ozone Standard on July 20, 2012. The EPA approved a re-designation of the area to Attainment with a Maintenance Plan effective on August 12, 2015.

## Fine Particulate Matter (PM2.5) – Maintenance Area for 2006 Daily Standard

The Knoxville Region was designated as Nonattainment for the 1997 Annual PM2.5 Standard on April 5, 2005 and the 2006 Daily PM2.5 Standard on December 14, 2009. The EPA approved a re-designation of the area to Attainment with a Maintenance Plan effective on August 28 and 29, 2017 for the daily and annual standards respectively. Since the Region is in attainment for the current, more stringent (2012) Annual PM2.5 Standard of 12  $\mu$ g/m3, the 1997 Standard was revoked for the Knoxville Region by EPA effective 8/29/2017.
