3. FY 2024-2025 TPO Work Program*



The Transportation Planning Work Program documents the transportation planning activities to be performed in the metropolitan planning area for the next two years. Major activities identified in the work program include: preparation of the 2050 Mobility Plan, travel demand model update, continued pavement management data collection and participation in a combined MPO statewide Household Travel Survey. The work program has been reviewed by TDOT and FHWA and all of their comments have been addressed in this final draft document.
