2. Minutes

Approved 12-0-0

A motion was made by Mayor Harris and seconded by Ms. Scott-Kelso to approve the Minutes of the December 20, 2023 Executive Board Meeting. The motion carried unanimously, 12-0.

3. 2020-2024 Safety Performance Measure Targets *



Federal regulations require states and MPOs to establish performance targets for five separate safety factors on an annual basis. TDOT established its 7th annual statewide safety targets for the 5-year period of 2020-2024 effective on August 31, 2023 and the TPO has 180 days to either agree to support the state target or establish specific numeric targets for a safety performance measure specific to our region.

Technical Committee recommends approval, 14-0.

Discussion

Mike Conger, TPO Staff, reviewed the 2020-2024 Safety Performance Measure Targets established by TDOT.

Approved 12-0-0

A motion was made by Mr. Biggs and seconded by Commissioner Hill to approve the Resolution to Adopt the 2020-2024 Safety Performance Measure Targets. The motion carried unanimously, 12-0.

4. Transportation Planning Work Program Amendment*

TPO staff proposes an amendment to the planning work program to clarify that task 2A, sub-task 12 (Regional Study of Pavement Conditions throughout the Knoxville TPO area) may include data collection outside the TPO Planning area for TPO member agencies. There is no financial change with the proposed amendment. *Technical Committee recommends approval, 14-0.*

5. FHWA & FTA - Overview of Knoxville TMA Certification Review

Every 4 years the TPO planning process is reviewed by our Federal Partners - Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), Federal Transit Administration (FTA), and Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). FHWA Tennessee Division staff will review the certification process and seek comments from the Executive Board on planning issues, priorities, and TPO activities.

7. Safe Streets & Roads for All (SS4A) Grants



The FY 2023 Implementation Grants under the II SS4A Discretionary Grant Program were announced on December 13, 2023 and the City of Knoxville was awarded \$8 Million for their SAFER Knoxville project. The TPO was awarded \$24,000 for planning to extend the Regional Roadway Safety Plan to cover the entirety of Anderson County. These awards will be discussed along next steps for a potential FY 2024 grant application.
