3. Transportation Planning Work Program*

There are two amendments for the Fiscal Year 22-23 Transportation Planning Work Program (TPWP). The first amendment adds specific language concerning the TPO's intention to hire a consultant to assist in preparing the Mobility Plan 2050. The funding to hire the consultant had already been included, but based on a TDOT recommendation additional task-related language needs to be added in order to be approved to hire a consultant. The second amendment is in response to Knoxville Area Transit and the City of Knoxville receiving a Federal Transit Administration - Areas of Persistent Poverty Program grant. This amendment will add the project and funding into the TPWP.

4. FTA Section 5310 Program of Projects*

The TPO is the designated recipient of the Federal Transit Administration Section 5310 funds. Section 5310 funds can be used for both operating and capital projects that support seniors and/or persons with disabilities. Often non-profits utilize this funding to buy vans to provide transportation for their clients. The TPO held an open and publicly advertised Call-for-Projects. A sub-committee of the Technical Committee reviewed the applications and developed a slate of draft projects for funding consideration. The attached draft Program-of-Projects and funding table show the sub-committee's recommendations. Project applications can be viewed online.

8. TDOT FY 2024-2026 3-Year Program Update

The FY 2024-2026 TDOT 3-Year Program was adopted by the State Legislature in April and includes the phases of major roadway projects to be funded statewide. TDOT project development staff will provide an overview of the projects included for the Knoxville Region in relation to the project rankings that were provided by the TPO late last year. An overview of the Tennessee Modernization Act which identifies \$3.3 Billion in additional funding for transportation projects across the state will also be provided.
