- Federal transit administration (FTA) funding
- Enhanced mobility of seniors & individuals with disabilities program
- TPO is the recipient for Knoxville urban area
- Held a call-for-projects
- Posted on-line, advertised in regional newspapers, mentioned at other meetings, and TPO has database of interested agencies
- Sub-committee reviewed applications & made recommendations



Section 5310 Program of Projects

- Awarding \$1,218,433 In federal funding (\$1,828,382 when matched)
- Sub-committee recommends \$133,884 for administration (24 months, consultant).
- TDOT typically provides half of local match, but will not commit until FTA approves grant. So, applicants are committed to providing the full match.
- Sevier County LIVE-IT has a portion of service area outside urban area (2/3 vote).
