



Member Population Threshold

TC/EB membership ... “governmental jurisdictions with a population of 5,000 or greater according to the latest decennial US census figures.”

- Do we allow the double-counting of the population (5,000 threshold)?
- What happens if we eliminate the threshold? Should we adjust threshold?
- What about a hybrid-option? EB versus TC


Staff Recommendation: Leave threshold at 5,000 and no double-counting.

Aligning Meeting Frequency of TC & EB

- The TC shall meet ... at least **bimonthly**.
- The EB Board shall meet at least **quarterly**.
- Nashville: The Technical Committee will typically meet monthly, but no less than quarterly.



Staff Recommendation: Aligning meeting frequency with Executive Board.

Officer Term



Current term of TC: office shall be for one year. Any officer is eligible to serve a maximum of two consecutive terms.

- This requires no change for the TC, but staff will recommend to the Executive Board that they make a change and align their terms with the TC.
- Executive Board is 2-year term, can serve two terms (4 years)
- Question: How should we count partial terms?

Staff Recommendation: Change Executive Board officer term to one year with a maximum of two consecutive terms.

TC Membership



Twelve staff members: One each to be designated by Alcoa, Clinton, Farragut, Lenoir City, City of Loudon, Maryville, Oak Ridge, Lakeway MTPO, and Anderson, Blount, Loudon, and Sevier Counties

Director of Transit – KAT,

Director – Tennessee Vans,


Director – Metropolitan Airport,

Director – Knoxville Knox County CAC,

TC Membership (cont.)


- Who appoints the twelve staff members?
- Are the members defined sufficiently?
- Do we still need to keep Lakeway MTPO on as a voting member?
Could be Ex-Officio?



Staff Recommendation: Government designees shall be determined by the principal elected official of that jurisdiction. Agency or organization designees shall be determined by the chief executive officer of that agency/organization.

TC Membership (cont.)

- Each TC member may designate, in writing, a representative to attend meetings in said member's absence. Is permanent representatives allowed – is this a proxy?
- How do we handle a proxy of a proxy. Are second proxies allowed? Who appoints the second proxy?



Staff Recommendation: Members are designated by their Mayor/Director. Proxies should only be for temporary absences and should be appointed by the Mayor/Director.

Other Issues

1. Each TC member shall have one vote, unless they have a proxy letter from another committee member – in this case, a committee member may have up to two votes.

This is in the Executive Board bylaws also.

Staff Recommendation: eliminate from bylaws.

2. Should staff be able to take items directly to Executive Board if they come up between meetings and are time sensitive?

Staff Recommendation: only in limited situations. This would not include any decision on local funding. Could include TDOT funding, endorsements, etc.
