### 3. TDOT and Knoxville Regional TPO Memorandum of Agreement

A Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) has been drafted to establish a mechanism for a fund swap approach for annual unobligated federal-aid highway funds. This MOA formalizes this process to be ongoing and could occur each year, in the future, as needed. The MOA will be reviewed at least every four years by TDOT and the TPO. This item was discussed at the July TPO meetings where general support for this process was expressed by both the TPO Technical Committee and Executive Board to allow TDOT to maximize its annual request for national August Redistribution funding.

## Attachment #3: Memorandum of Agreement Discussion

Stacy Morrison, TDOT Staff, outlined the proposed Memorandum of Agreement between TDOT and the TPO.

### **Approved** 16-0-0

Ms. Baldwin moved to recommend approval of the Memorandum of Agreement between TDOT and the Knoxville Regional TPO to the Executive Board. Mr. Messer seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

## 4. FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Project (TIP) Cost Overrun

Review of a cost overrun request for a locally sponsored project. The overrun exceeds the limits established in the TIP programming policies adopted with the FY 23-26 TIP. Technical Committee approval is required for cost overruns in excess of 25% of the total project cost or increasing TPO federal funds in excess of \$500,000.

Knoxville's Sevier Avenue South Knoxville Waterfront Roadway Improvements: Overrun request (L-STBG funds) is \$1,164,396 (+\$1,238,441 federal/-\$74,045 local), representing 11.7% of the total project cost.

# 5. Midpoint Performance Measure Target Adjustments related to the FHWA PM-3 Subpart G (Traffic Congestion) Area

The TPO became subject to target-setting under Subpart G of the FHWA Performance Measure regulations with the 2nd 4-Year Performance Period covering from 2022 through 2025. Subpart G includes two measures related to traffic congestion and are specific to only the Knoxville Urbanized Area u2013 (1) Peak Hour Excessive Delay (PHED) and (2) % of Non-Single Occupancy Vehicle (% Non-SOV) Travel. A midpoint assessment has been performed and adjustments to the 4-year targets are proposed in recognition of the data trends. These targets are developed in conjunction with TDOT who shares them with the TPO.
