#### **Comments:**

Modification #504: Modify grouping to revise the programming for Fort Sanders Neighborhood to Tyson Park Connection & First Creek Greenway - Broadway Streetscape projects to reflect the most recent estimates and schedules and revise the federal funding sources. Fort Sanders Neighborhood to Tyson Park Connection schedule is updated to reflect obligated PE-N in FY 2025, shift PE-D and ROW to FY 2026 and remove the construction phase from the grouping. Estimated phase costs are unchanged. First Creek Greenway - Broadway Streetscape project is programmed for additional PE-N costs in FY 2025 of \$27,750 CRP (\$22,200 federal/\$5,550 local). PE-D is programmed in FY 2025 and increased to \$200,000 CRP (\$160,000 federal/\$40,000 local). ROW is programmed in FY 2025 and increased to \$1,072,600 CRP (\$858,080 federal/\$214,520 local). Construction is programmed in FY 2026 at a total cost of \$4,666,795 (\$2,400,000 federal SS4A/\$1,333,436 L-STBG-TA/\$933,359 local). This modification removes \$2,807,855 (-\$720,000 federal L-STBG/-\$3,066,564 federal L-STBG-TA/-\$859,720 federal CRP/+\$2,400,000 federal SS4A/-\$561,571 local) from the grouping and the TIP and reduces the total grouping cost to \$72,666,379.

## **Comments:**

Modification #590: Modify grouping to revise the programming for the East Knox Greenway, Ph. 1, Fort Sanders Neighborhood to Tyson Park Connection & South Knoxville Bridge Greenway projects to reflect the most recent estimates and schedules and revise some federal funding sources.

East Knox Greenway, Ph. 1 project is programmed for PE-N in FY 2025 at a total cost of \$174,380 L-STBG-TA (\$139,504 federal/\$34,876 local). PE-D is programmed in FY 2025 and increased to \$462,580 L-STBG-TA (\$370,064 federal/\$92,516 local). ROW is programmed in FY 2025 and increased to \$527,500 CRP (\$422,000 federal/\$105,500 local). The construction phase is removed from the TIP.

Fort Sanders Neighborhood to Tyson Park Connection is updated to increase PE-N and PE-D costs and remove the ROW phase. Additional PE-N costs are programmed in FY 2025 at a cost of \$94,470 L-STBG-TA (\$75,576 federal/\$18,894 local). PE-D phase in FY 2026 is increased to \$686,300 L-STBG-TA (\$549,040 federal/\$137,260 local). The ROW phase is removed from the TIP.

South Knoxville Bridge Greenway is updated to increase PE-D costs and update the project schedule. Additional PE-D costs are programmed in FY 2025 at a cost of \$11,500 L-STBG-TA (\$9,200 federal/\$2,300 local). The construction phase is moved from FY 2024 to FY 2026 with no change in phase costs.

This modification removes \$2,903,460 (-\$3,016,152 federal L-STBG/+\$671,384 federal L-STBG-TA/+\$22,000 federal CRP/-\$580,692 local) from the grouping and the TIP and reduces the total grouping cost to \$69,762,919.
